**Mini Embellishment Scissors Fob**

The Mini Embellishment Scissors Fob is a complete kit that contains everything necessary to complete the project. Many stitchers will be able to finish the piece the day of the workshop.

The project is basic to intermediate level and is stitched on a 5" x 8" piece of black/iridescent 18 count canvas. Stitches include the cross stitch over 2, tent/continental, simple running stitch, and brick stitch beading using size 11 Delica beads. Kit threads are jewel-toned Frye Werks Soft Sheen, #8 Kreinik metallic, and cotton floss. Included in the kit is a size 26 needle. Both materials and processes for the twisted cord and tassel are part of the workshop as well as finishing the back of the fob.

There are three color choices available: raspberry, aqua, and purple. Your color choice will be made upon arrival at the workshop.

Students should bring 5" x 8" stretcher bars, their usual stitching supplies, and magnification as needed. A portable light is strongly advised.

Nancy Cucci of Huntington Beach, California, earned her B.A. in Physical Education from the University of California, Santa Barbara, and holds Lifetime Standard Secondary and Community College Teaching Credentials. In 1985 Nancy began teaching classes at local needlepoint shops and presenting programs & workshops for needlepoint guilds in Southern California. Nancy is a member of EGA, TNNA, NETA, and an ANG Life Patron. She began teaching on the national level in 2004 and is always happy to have the opportunity to share her energy and lifelong enthusiasm for stitching with her students.
