Additional Information

Pumpkins: The pumpkins were made from needlepoint panels donated to the guild. Rozelle Hirschfelt collected the tops from pumpkins and incorporated this natural feature when creating each pumpkin, giving them a unique look.

Queen Elizabeth I: The unstitched needlepoint panels for the Queen, plus some of the needed fibers, were a donation to Stitchers' Fair. Always looking for a great project for our fund raiser, Candy Marang rescued the kit and proceeded to complete the stitching, making adjustments based on available materials as she went. The underskirt is stitched in silk, the overskirt is wool. An assortment of other materials were used. Thankfully, most of her original decorative accessories were still in the kit. Julie Kerner completed the finishing.

Monkey: The fully stitched panels for the monkey were donated for our fund raiser by the stitchers in the Ohio Alpha Chapter (Canton) of ANG. Diana Rorabaugh presented the guild with her group's outstanding work. The monkey is covered by a variety of stitches and fibers including metallics and braids. Julie Kerner finished him as a jointed toy with a removable fez hat and vest and bendable tail.
